Why Prop 408 Is Important

What is Prop 408 all about?

 The ballot initiative before the voters this November is a short-term relief to the funding problems associated with restrictive legislation.
This legislation hampers our ability to acquire necessary operating funds.

Will this temporary rate increase impact my annual taxes?

- There will be a slight increase in your Fire District taxes, but only as much as is needed to offset increased operational expenses such as increasing health care, fuel, utilities, insurance, and state mandated retirement costs.
- At the end of the five-year period, and as the lessening of the impact of the past real estate recession are overcome, this temporary increase will be rescinded.

What happens if I vote No on Proposition 408?

 There will be continued cuts that will affect future fire, EMS, and community services in Munds Park.
